



The Haskins Giving Society is comprised of an esteemed group of dedicated alumni and friends who have a lasting impact on the School. Of the \$30.6 million we raised this past year, Haskins Giving Society members alone contributed \$22.4 million.

YOUR LEADERSHIP GIFTS IN ACTION IN 2016-2017

FINANCIAL AID

- 53 undergraduate students on fulltuition scholarships by the 2018-2019 academic year
- 27 new scholarships established by Haskins Giving Society members

CAREER DEVELOPMENT

- 98% of undergraduate students secured a full time job within 6 months of graduation
- **94%** of MBA students secured a full time job within 3 months of graduation

NT STUDENT SUPPORT

- \$300K in cash and services for NYU Stern's Entrepreneurs Challenge, an increase from \$100K
 - 379 undergraduate student participants in the Stern Program for Undergraduate Research
 - MBA students pursued a Social Impact Internship working at the intersection of business and society
 - 4 student entrepreneurs in the inaugural year of the Stern Venture Fellows program receiving financial support, mentorship, and access to NYC and Silicon Valley tech companies


