

ADVANCED STANDING AGREEMENT

Students have the option to receive advanced standing credit toward their degree for approved subjects based on Advanced Placement (AP) examinations with scores of 4 or 5; International Baccalaureate higher-level examinations with scores of 6 or 7; and certain Maturity Certificate Examinations approved by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. The maximum number of credits earned toward degree requirements as a result of nonresident special examinations cannot exceed 32 credits. Credit may also be received for approved college-level courses completed at an accredited institution in accordance with the Stern residency requirement, see the Stern Academic Bulletin for specific details.

I acknowledge the following:

Advanced standing credit accelerates a student through the degree program. If courses are not properly sequenced, scheduling difficulties may potentially develop.

Student Initials

For students considering a second major and/or minor, advanced standing credit could result in an excess of 128 credits. Federal, state, and institutional sources of financial aid may be discontinued once 128 credits have been completed. Students are not guaranteed an extension of aid eligibility to complete additional coursework.
