Position Summary

The CREFR is looking to hire a research assistant to assist the real estate faculty at NYU Stern in their research endeavors. The work supports the entire lifecycle of a research process, ranging from assistance with data collection, data analysis, and coding to proofreading and editing. The main project the research assistant would be working on is a joint project between NYU Stern and JLL related to U.S. institutional commercial real estate with the objective of creating academic research papers. The assistant would provide research support for both publications that aim at academic journals and more policy-oriented work. Second, the research assistant would also assist in doing background research for and drafting summaries of the real estate conferences and the other events that the CREFR holds and that can be disseminated through our website, newsletter, and annual report.

Qualifications/Required Education: Bachelor's degree (in economics, mathematics, statistics, finance)

Preferred Education: Master's Degree or Ph.D. candidate

Preferred Experience: The ideal candidate will have two or more years' experience as data analyst or pursuing independent research. Candidates must have extensive analytic and quantitative research experience at undergraduate or graduate level.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Proficiency with programming in statistical packages such as STATA and MATLAB. Strong analytical and writing skills.

Preferred Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Proficiency using real estate related databases such as, Trepp, Bloomberg, REIS, etc.
