What if I change my mind?

	Canceling/ Reducing Loans	Reinstating Loans
Timeline	Within 120 days of disbursement	By the end of the semester
Contact	Bursar	Financial Aid
When to contact?	Within 110 days of disbursement	A couple weeks in advance
Interest Accrued?	No, a return on principal	N/A

Loan Disbursements & Refunds

Submit the Bursar's **Tuition & Fees Worksheet** on or before your payment deadline on

January 8, 2018

The disbursement date for federal loans is 10 days prior to a student's first class



Loans disburse to Bursar. Funds are applied to student's balance



Bursar refunds students via Direct Deposit or check for funds received in excess of their balance
