Ms. Patterson is Chief Investment Officer at Bessemer Trust, managing more than \$70 billion worth of high-net-worth family assets. She is also a member of the firm's Management Committee.

Prior to joining Bessemer, Rebecca worked at J.P. Morgan, as Chief Markets Strategist for Asset Management, as Global Head of Foreign Exchange and Commodities for the Private Bank, and as an Investment Banking Research Analyst, based in New York, London and Singapore where she helped central banks and sovereign wealth funds, other institutional clients and high-net-worth families. Prior to J.P. Morgan, she was a journalist in the U.S. and Europe.

She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, the New York Federal Reserve's Investor Advisory Committee, the Economic Club of New York, and chairs the University of Florida Investment Corporation's Advisory Board. Additionally, Rebecca is a regular CNBC contributor; her views on the global economy and financial markets are frequently sought by media and for industry conferences. *American Banker* has named her one of "The 25 Most Powerful Women in Finance" for the past four consecutive years.
