- Research and share general market best practices for SRI data capture and impact measurement
- Work with CPG SRI team to review and update SRI metrics for relevant CPG investments
- Work with managers on what is possible to capture and measure in their investments
- Compile portfolio level impact statistics
- Compile portfolio exposures to SRI issues
- Review and enhance template for compiling data going forward
- Contribute to research on drivers for fossil fuel demand
