

# Spring registration guide

Here are some basic tips for spring registration. For more detailed guidance, review your curriculum worksheet and plan accordingly. Remember: You should be in 16-18 credits each semester, unless you are a final semester senior!

Freshman	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required: <i>SOIM-UB 1 Business &amp; Its Publics</i> (1 credit)- this will already be added to your schedule</li> <li>Required: <i>SOIM-UB 125 Business &amp; Its Publics</i> (3 credits) – enroll yourself based on cohort</li> <li><b>EXCEPTION: Students who took EXPOS-UA 4 International Writing Workshop (4 credits) in the Fall semester must enroll in EXPOS-UA 9 International Writing Workshop II (4 credits)</b></li> <li>Explore the Liberal Arts Core &amp; Business Tools</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required: <i>SOIM-UB 1 Business &amp; Its Publics</i> (1 credit)- this will already be added to your schedule</li> <li>Required: <i>SOIM-UB 125 Business &amp; Its Publics</i> (3 credits) – enroll yourself based on cohort</li> <li>Required: Must have completed Stern Microeconomics and Statistics requirements by the end of Spring semester</li> <li>Recommended: <i>ACCT-UB 1 Principles of Financial Accounting</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Recommended: <i>BPEP-UB 2 Introduction to Macroeconomics</i> (4 credits) – can be taken in London sophomore fall</li> </ul>
Sophomore	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Before junior spring: <i>ECON-UB 11 Economics of Global Business</i> (4 credits) (pre-requisite: <i>ECON-UB 1 Microeconomics</i>)</li> <li>Before junior spring: <i>SOIM-UB 65 Organizational Communication &amp; Its Social Context</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Explore the Business Core and other elective courses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required: <i>BPEP-UB 9011 International Political Economy</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Before junior spring: <i>SOIM-UB 65 Organizational Communication &amp; Its Social Context</i> (4 credits) and <i>ECON-UA 9238 International Economics</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Recommended: Area Studies elective</li> <li>Explore the Business Core and other elective courses</li> </ul>
Junior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required by end of junior spring: <i>SOIM-UB 6 Law, Business &amp; Society</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Required: <i>MULT-UB 11 International Studies Program</i> (4 credits) – make sure to register for a section specific to your assigned location (pre-requisites: <i>SOIM-UB 65 Org. Comm.</i> &amp; <i>ECON-UB 11 EGB</i>) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you are studying away during Junior Spring, you must take an ISP alternative course upon your return</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required by end of junior spring: <i>SOIM-UB 6 Law, Business &amp; Society</i> (4 credits)</li> <li>Required by end of junior spring: Regional Political Economy course (4 credits)</li> <li>Optional: <i>MULT-UB 11 International Studies Program</i> (4 credits) – make sure to register for a section specific to your assigned location (pre-requisites: <i>SOIM-UB 65 Org. Comm.</i> &amp; <i>ECON-UA 9238 International Economics</i>)</li> </ul>
Senior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete concentration, minor and any other remaining required courses</li> <li>Make sure you are on track for graduation by checking your <a href="#">Degree Progress Report on Albert</a></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete remaining required courses, including your language requirement, before graduation</li> <li>Make sure you are on track for graduation by checking your <a href="#">Degree Progress Report on Albert</a></li> </ul>
