### **PRESENTATION TIPS**

- Be clear and be brief. Speak loudly and slowly, but be sure to get through your pitch in 90 seconds or less. We may have to cut you off after that time due to the large number of presenters.
- Share as much or as little of your idea as you wish. The goal here is not fundraising or even education. It is simply to generate interest in your idea so that potential teammates will contact you.
- Don't forget to tell the audience your assigned Alias!
- Don't be nervous. Instead, relax, have fun and project confidence. This is a safe environment with an open-minded audience who is excited to hear what you have to say.
