

Wendy Edelberg is the chief macroeconomist of the Congressional Budget Office, which she joined in 2011. Just before arriving at the agency, she was the executive director of the Financial Crisis Inquiry Commission, which released its report on the causes of the recent financial crisis in January 2011. Previously, she worked on issues related to macroeconomics, housing, and consumer spending at the President's Council of Economic Advisers during two administrations. Before that, she worked on those same issues at the Federal Reserve Board.
