Setting up posts for grading

When <u>creating a forum</u>, choose to grade either the entire forum or individual threads.

NOTE: Allowing students to create their own threads disables the ability to grade threads, since students will be able to create multiple threads and clutter the **Grade Center**. If you're planning on creating forums and allowing students to create their own threads, choose **Grade Forum** and enter the overall points possible.
