

## **Subscribing to Forums**

If a user subscribes to a forum or thread, they receive an email when a forum or thread has been updated. When <u>creating a forum</u>, faculty/instructors can choose to allow students to subscribe to threads or entire forums, and also decide whether students will be able to receive a simple link to the updated post or receive the entire body of the post in their email.
