

Inter-Club Council

Overview

Stern has an active club system comprised of 25 members. The clubs promote professional development in a broad range of industries and interests, from finance and accounting to social impact and entertainment. Many of the clubs focus on career development and cultivate strong relationships with companies and organizations as well as Stern alumni who continue to support the club system by attending or speaking at events. More than 60% of Stern students participate in the club system.

The Inter-Club Council (ICC) is the governing body of 25 member clubs and is overseen by the Office of Student Engagement (OSE). ICC is charged with creating cohesion between the clubs, marketing events to the Stern community, and planning large-scale events that further promote the club system.

- Interact with students who are interested in the company and its respective industry
- Increase the company's brand visibility at Stern

Company Expectations

When working with a club, companies must:

- Register with the Office of Student Engagement before attending a club event or participating in any Stern campus events

When working with a club, companies should not:

- Recruit directly through the clubs
- Make any payments directly to students or clubs
