The NYU Stern Executive MBA in DC program is designed for experienced, working professionals to pursue an MBA while working full-time, in a cohort-based format.



RESIDENCIES

During the 24 months of coursework, students attend courses once a month on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. In addition to class weekends, students participate in residencies that bring our students together in a collaborative community and develop a global perspective.

Domestic Residencies

Year 1 begins with a one-week domestic residency that starts off with an orientation day and continues with students starting core courses throughout the week. Year 2 begins with a 9-day domestic residency comprised of two consecutive weekends and a week in between. Both domestic residencies take place all day and happen in real-time, so please ensure you obtain the necessary time off from work to complete them.

Global Study Tour

Each cohort embarks on up to two Global Study Tours. These one-week international residencies are an integral component of the curriculum. Students participate in a required Global Study Tour during the first year of the program and have the opportunity to participate in an optional Global Study Tour in their second year. Global Study Tour destinations are carefully selected by Stern faculty and administration with a focus on relevant business trends and current events. The second-year destination will typically be very different from the first, allowing students to compare two distinct dynamic and contemporary markets.

Recent classes have studied in Argentina, Brazil, China, Greece, the UAE, India, Korea, Japan, Spain and Vietnam. While abroad, students will participate in meetings and in-depth discussions with leaders of industry, financial institutions, government organizations, and key NYU faculty.

Global Study Tour program activities are arranged and paid for by the Executive MBA Program, with the following exceptions:

- International airfare (at the start and end of the program)
- Dinners on your own
- Any required visas and passport fees
- Airport transfers
- Any incidental expenses incurred during your time abroad

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

Scholarships

The NYU Stern Executive MBA program is proud to support applicants through scholarships. We offer partial merit-based scholarships each year to selected applicants receiving minimal or no financial sponsorship from their employer. All scholarships are individual, one-time awards and are applied toward Year 1 tuition payments.

Scholarship decisions are made based on an overall review of the formal application and its required components and the interview. Applicants will automatically be considered for all available scholarships and will be notified at the time of admission if selected. Award amounts range from \$5,000 to \$15,000 and are determined by the Admissions Committee.

Executive MBA Dean's Scholarship

Merit-based scholarship awarded based on a range of criteria including prior academic achievement, professional accomplishments, and demonstration of leadership and teamwork abilities.

Executive MBA Advancing Diversity in Business Scholarship

Merit-based scholarship awarded to applicants who demonstrate a deep and abiding commitment to advancing diversity in business.

Executive MBA Social Impact Scholarship

Merit-based scholarship awarded to applicants with demonstrated leadership or significant contributions in the public and/or non-profit sectors.

Executive MBA Sustainability Scholarship

Merit-based scholarship awarded to applicants who are committed to making an impact through sustainability in their industry or function.

NYU Stern offers opportunities for alumni to continually develop and grow academically in conjunction with their professional growth. All Stern EMBA alumni have access to:


- Two free Executive Education courses every year and a 50% discount on additional in-person and online courses and certificate programs
