

Return on Sustainability Investment Research Intern **Fall 2026**

The ROSI Research Intern will have a variety of tasks, including editing ROSI published and new ROSI research documentation to meet NYU accessibility standards, and cataloguing data sources for ROSI calculations.

Roles/Responsibilities:

- Update existing and new research materials to ensure adherence to NYU accessibility standards
- Review existing ROSI calculation research and rewrite/edit it so that it is ready for AI extraction and assessment.
- Identify, evaluate, and catalog public and private sustainability datasets (emissions data, supply chain data, sustainability disclosures, environmental indicators, etc.)
- Identify proxy data for ROSI calculations to be used as needed.

Logistics:

- Researcher will be remote, with potential in-person meetings at Stern
- Researcher will connect with the ROSI Team 1-2 times/week
- Position starts ASAP; roughly 5-10 hrs/week during the fall semester
- Position may continue into Winter 2027
- Position is compensated through or hourly pay

In compliance with NYC's Pay Transparency Act, the hourly base salary range for undergraduate student employment positions is \$17 per hour.

Qualifications:

- Attention to detail
 - The ability to edit research for accessibility while preserving original intent
- Demonstrated ability to convey concepts and ideas in writing to a broad audience
- Strong analytical skills
- Open to NYU Undergraduate students; NYU Stern students preferred
