NRDC is seeking an MBA Intern to work with the American Cities Climate Challenge team in our New York office. The role will be paid, part time (10 hours/week) for 12-14 weeks between 15 Sep 2019 and 31 December 2019.

The American Cities Climate Challenge is an unprecedented opportunity for 25 ambitious cities to significantly deepen and accelerate their efforts to tackle climate change and promote a sustainable future for their residents. Originally open to 20 American cities, the program was expanded to 25 cities due to the strength of the applications received.

As Climate Challenge winners, 25 cities have been accepted into a two-year acceleration program with powerful new resources and access to cutting-edge support to help them meet – or beat – their near-term carbon reduction goals. These resources include a philanthropy-funded team member to facilitate the development and passage of high impact policies, training for senior leadership to assist with implementation of their proposed climate plans, and citizen engagement support to maximize community buy-in.

This internship will be paid jointly by the Natural Resources Defense Council and the NYU/Stern Center for Sustainable Business.
