

Spring registration guide

Here are some basic tips for spring registration. For more detailed guidance, review your curriculum worksheet and plan accordingly. Remember: You should be in 16-18 credits each semester, unless you are a final semester senior!

Junior	 Required by end of junior year: SOIM-UB 6 Law, Business & Society (4 credits) Required: MULT-UB 11 International Studies Program (4 credits) – make sure to register for a section specific to your assigned location (prerequisites: SOIM-UB 65 Org. Comm. & ECON-UB 11 EGB) If you are studying away during Junior Spring, you must take an ISP alternative course upon your return – speak to an adviser 	 Required by end of junior year: SOIM-UB 6 Law, Business & Society (4 credits) Optional: MULT-UB 11 International Studies Program (4 credits) – make sure to register for a section specific to your assigned location (prerequisites: SOIM-UB 65 Org. Comm. & ECON-UA 9238 International Economics)
Senior	 Complete concentration, minor and any other remaining required courses Make sure you are on track for graduation by checking your <u>Degree</u> <u>Progress Report on Albert</u> 	 Complete remaining required courses, including your language requirement, before graduation Make sure you are on track for graduation by checking your <u>Degree Progress</u> <u>Report on Albert</u>
