- 1) To understand the role and importance of assurance services and independent auditors to the capital markets, private and public enterprise and the global economy. To understand why gaining this knowledge is important to future accountants and business decision makers whether or not they plan to become auditors.
- 2) To understand the theory, concepts, professional and legal standards and procedures underlying assurance services, particularly audits of financial statements by independent public accountants.
- 3). To understand the basics of how to conduct a financial statement audit including the analytical and logical skills necessary to evaluate the relevance and reliability of financial information as well as of the systems and processes responsible for recording and summarizing that information.
